- Require every employee to take personal responsibility for HSEQ by focusing on own behavior and adherence to Company policies and industry best practices.
- Ensure the Company Management of Change process is followed for any changes to planned or on-going operational, administrative, strategic and organisational matters with a risk potential.
- Consider all accidents, incidents and occupational illnesses to be preventable.
- Report and respond to all incidents and undesired situations.
- Promote healthy working conditions and a working culture which empowers all personnel to actively consult and participate in the Company HSEQ processes.
- Encourage own employees, suppliers and partners to be pro-active and use products and technical solutions with the least negative impact to health and the environment.
- Set and regularly review objectives and targets with the aim of continuous improvement.
- Monitor HSEQ performance and address deficiencies where identified.
- Ensure that the organization, through training and exercises, increase the individual skills and preparedness for normal operations as well as different emergency situations.
